Item Matter Action DF has been focused on the ANZDATA training projects, with an EOI currently open to support five trainee projects and has also been working on the head of unit capacity report, which will be presented by NG at the upcoming DNT meeting. There is also a nursing unit manager capacity survey open currently, which will inform dialysis chair numbers going forward. ANZDATA is looking to formalize and solidify the governance structure for the broader ANZDATA registries group. KH ANNOUNCED that she will be finishing up in her position as General Manager at the end of the current funding agreement, after 14 years of service. ANZDATA will be undertaking a review of the role and advertising for a replacement. 4. **Working Groups**

4.1 **WG** Updates

Members **NOTED** updates from:

PROMs Working Group by RM:

- Granted funding to develop PROMs modules for the Registry, involving a Delphi process to identify which PROMs should be included.
- The goal is to allow patients to securely log in and complete the PROMs online, which will be integrated with the website redevelopment.
- There are plans for a pilot implementation in 5-6 units.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Working Group by SB:

- The First Nations infographic has reached the end of its copyright agreement.
- EOI to form a consumer working group to provide input on the infographic content and design was announced at the NIKTT Gathering.

PD Working Group by JC:

- A plan to submit a new variable proposal to expand the PD infection variable to include tunnel infections is underway.
- The definition and timing of "pre-PD peritonitis" are in discussion, as there are inconsistencies in how this is captured.
- WG is following up with units on missing data for adequacy tests and PET tests to determine if it is due to not reporting or not performing the tests.

HD Working Group by MR:

They plan to invite the data statisticians and ANZSN QISC chair to their next meeting to discuss the access-related bacteraemia data that started collection this year. Action item: Coordinate the meeting with the data statisticians and QISC chair.

Parenthood Working Group by SJ:

- A paper on labour and delivery outcomes for Australian transplanted women has been published in JAMA.
- Currently working on additional analyses around home dialysis and pregnancy.
- A collaboration with the French registry to leverage their linkage with perinatal data is being explored as a potential project.

Paediatric Working Group by HMC:

There is a need for an annual infographic summary designed specifically for patients and families. WG seeks the ANZDATA team's support in collaborating to develop a clear and meaningful infographic that effectively communicates key information.

KHA Update 5.

Members **NOTED** updates from BR:

- KHA launched a project around ending dialysis by 2050 in late 2021, now developing a strategy with 10 pillars to work towards this goal, covering areas like early detection, equity in transplants, and increasing living donors.
- KHA has hired a new Program Manager for First Nations Kidney Health, who is engaging with communities, especially in the Pilbara, Central Australia, and Northern Territory, for a pilot program around early detection of kidney disease.
- For World Kidney Day, KHA's focus will be on advocacy, including media releases, an advocacy webinar for patient advocates, and trying to generate awareness around the need for people to get checked for kidney disease.
- In this year Q3, KHA plans to hold a national summit on early detection of kidney disease, aiming to develop a consensus paper and roadmap to inform KHA's strategy and advocacy work.
