About SWIFT

SWIFT aims to see if adults who are managed with hemodialysis for kidney failure can benefit from systematic monitoring of their symptoms (like tiredness, itching, pain) and if feedback of these symptoms to their nurses and kidney doctors improves patients' overall quality of life. This trial is run by University of Sydney in collaboration with ANZDATA.

Milestone Achieved

SWIFT has completed recruitment across **92** centres in **4** Australian states with over **2000** participants and is now officially in follow-up!

This marks SWIFT as the **Largest** haemodialysis trial conducted in Australia!
