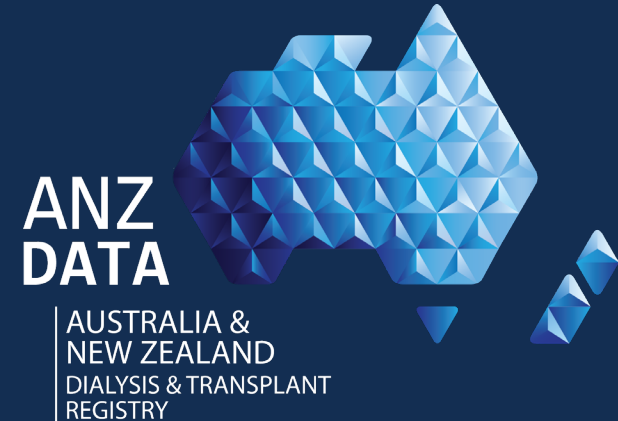

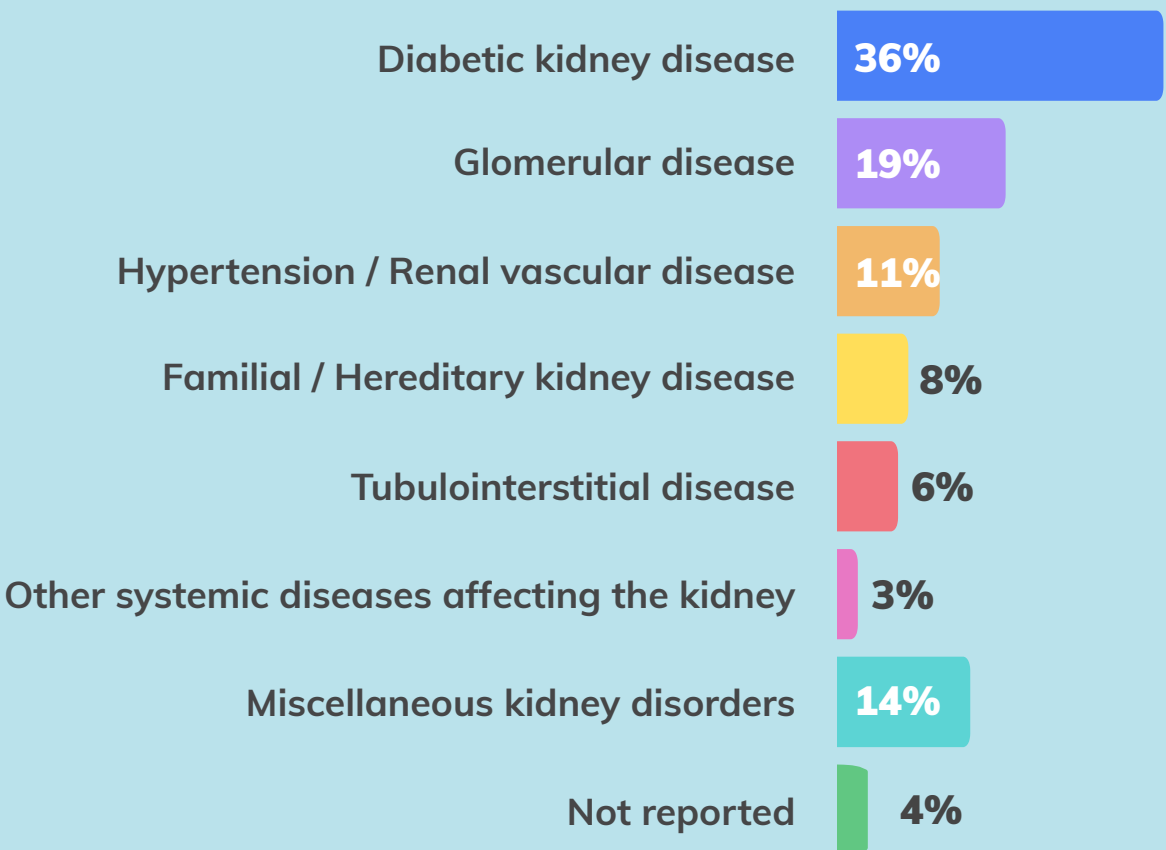

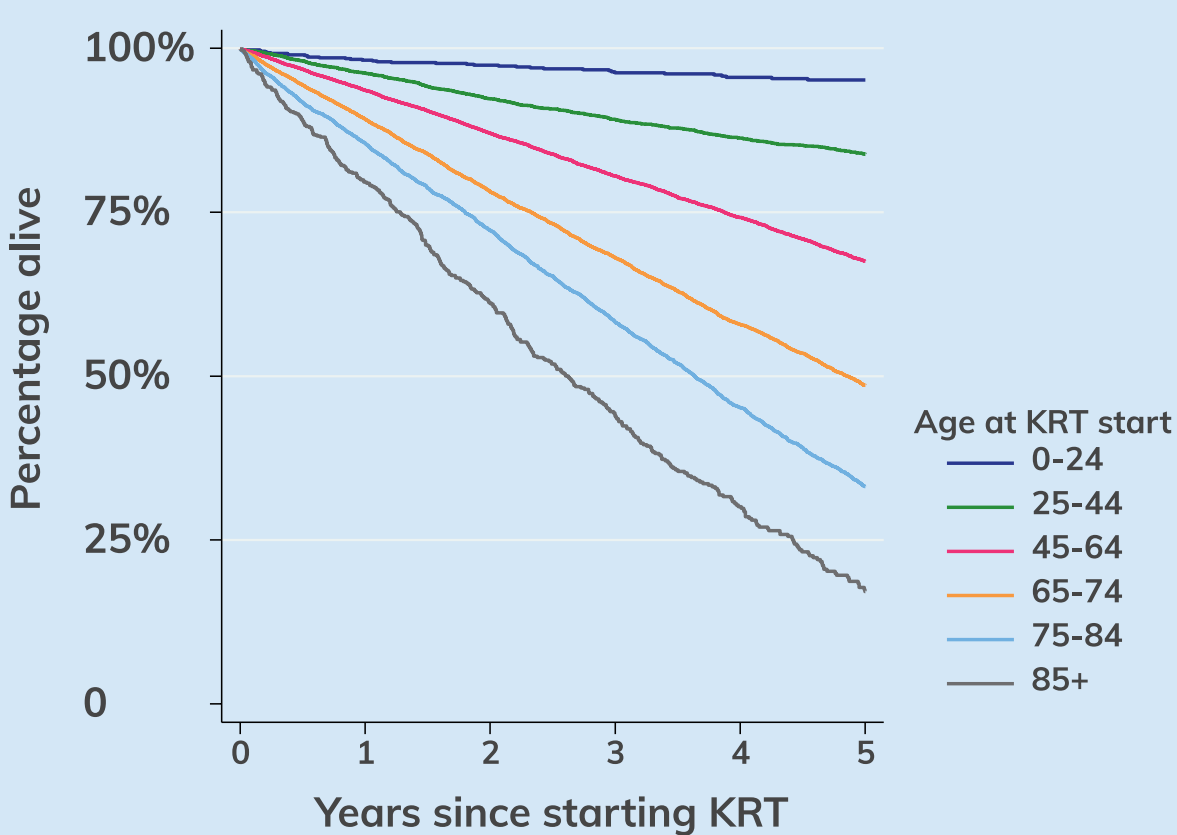

Each bar shows how common that cause of kidney failure was among people who started KRT* in 2025.

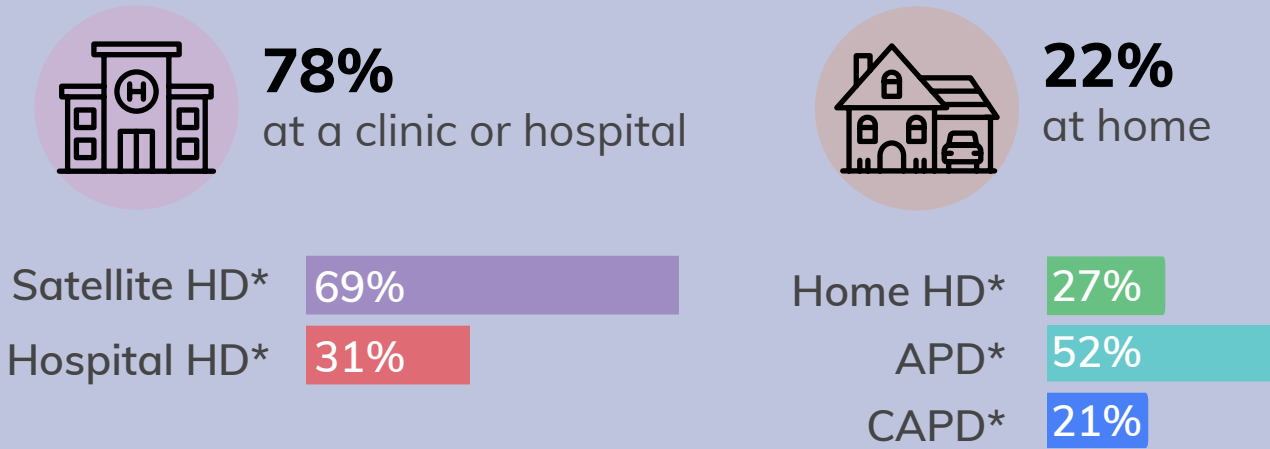
How long do people survive?



The graph shows what percentage of people, by age group, are alive at different time points after starting KRT.

How did people receive treatment in 2025?

53% of people receive **dialysis**



47% of people live with a **kidney transplant**



What about the transplant waitlist?
