## **About SWIFT**

SWIFT aims to see if people who are managed with hemodialysis for kidney failure can benefit from systematic monitoring of their symptoms (like tiredness, itching, pain) and if feedback of these symptoms to their nurses and kidney doctors improves patients' overall quality of life. This trial is run by University of Sydney in collaboration with ANZDATA.
