About SWIFT

SWIFT aims to see if adults who are managed with hemodialysis for kidney failure can benefit from systematic monitoring of their symptoms (like tiredness, itching, pain) and if feedback of these symptoms to their nurses and kidney doctors improves patients' overall quality of life. This trial is run by University of Sydney in collaboration with ANZDATA.

Investigator Meeting

Participant Eligibility

We would like to remind all units to ensure all participants meet eligibility criteria. A recent serious protocol breach occurred when a 17.5-year-old was enrolled in an adult HD unit. After a thorough review of all baseline data, we have confirmed this was an isolated incident. The matter was managed in full compliance with HREC regulations, and all mandatory reporting requirements have been completed. Further details have been shared via email with Primary Investigators and Associate Investigators at participating sites.
