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Note on Reports from the Real-Time Database

This report has been generated from the “real-time” database, as contributed by units at the date of publication. Results are dependent on the timeliness and completeness of data submission by units. We try to provide indices to allow evaluation of the completeness both overall and for individual hospitals. However, results are preliminary and subject to change. The subsequent report from the Analysis database, following the end of year survey, will provide the final results for this observation period.

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1 Incidence of Peritonitis in Patients Treated with Peritoneal Dialysis

1.1 Adult

This table presents the total number of peritonitis episodes and patient exposure in years by Centre. Patient totals, exposure and peritonitis episodes were determined using the hospital at which the patient was receiving treatment at the time. So, if a patient transferred units during the observation period, the subsequent exposure and peritonitis episodes were allocated to the new unit. Months per episode (PM per Episode) is also reported. This should be interpreted as the average number of months between episodes of peritonitis; it can not be calculated if the peritonitis rate is zero. The half-yearly average number of 2025 episodes are based on the 2025 analysis database and are provided to allow assessment of possible under-reporting. This is a particular issue with peritonitis reporting. Patients are excluded from this adult report if they were treated at a paediatric hospital. In rare cases when patients younger than 18 years are treated at an adult centre, they are included in this adult report. Any patients 18 years and older treated at a paediatric hospital are excluded from this report. This quality indicator is presented for Australia only as New Zealand peritonitis episode data is reported through the New Zealand Peritoneal Dialysis Registry. Note that the 2022 International Society for Peritoneal Dialysis peritonitis guideline has a target that the overall peritonitis rate should be no more than 0.40 episodes per year at risk.

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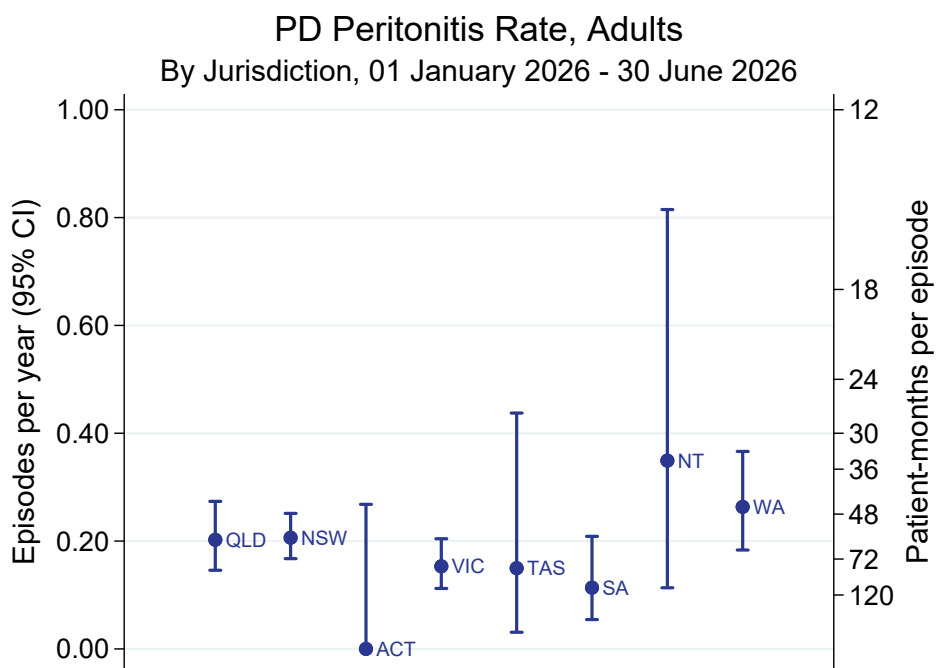
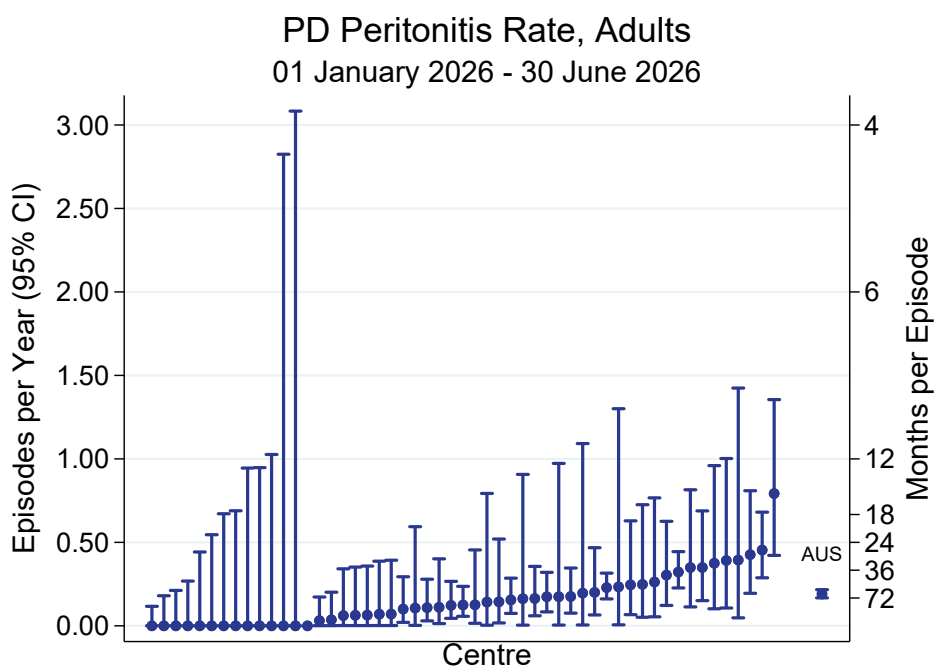

2 Dialysis Access Planning at Commencement of Dialysis

2.1 All Dialysis Access Planning

2.1.1 Adult

This table presents the numbers of patients beginning haemodialysis or peritoneal dialysis and the percentage starting with a permanent access (an AVF or AVG for haemodialysis and all peritoneal dialysis patients) during the observation window by Centre, where dialysis was the first kidney replacement therapy. Patients are excluded from this adult report if they were treated at a paediatric hospital. In rare cases when patients younger than 18 years are treated at an adult centre, they are included in this adult report. Any patients 18 years and older treated at a paediatric hospital are excluded from this report. Some Centres did not report type of first access for all new HD patients. The percent beginning with a permanent access is based on the number of patients with data available for first access. The half-yearly average number of new dialysis patients for 2025 from the analysis database is also provided to allow assessment of possible under-reporting. Finally, the total of Early Referrals (patients seen more than 3 months before first treatment) and the percentage of Early Referrals with a permanent access are also presented.

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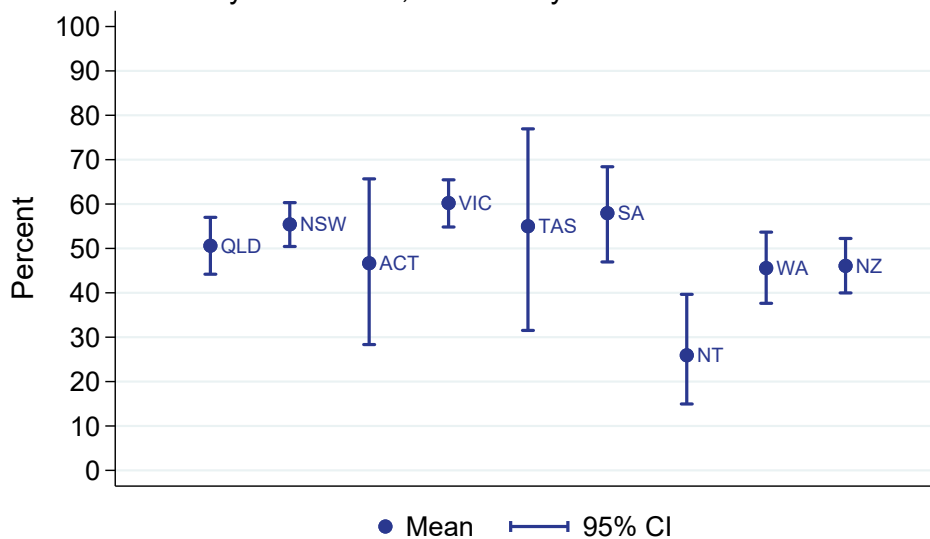

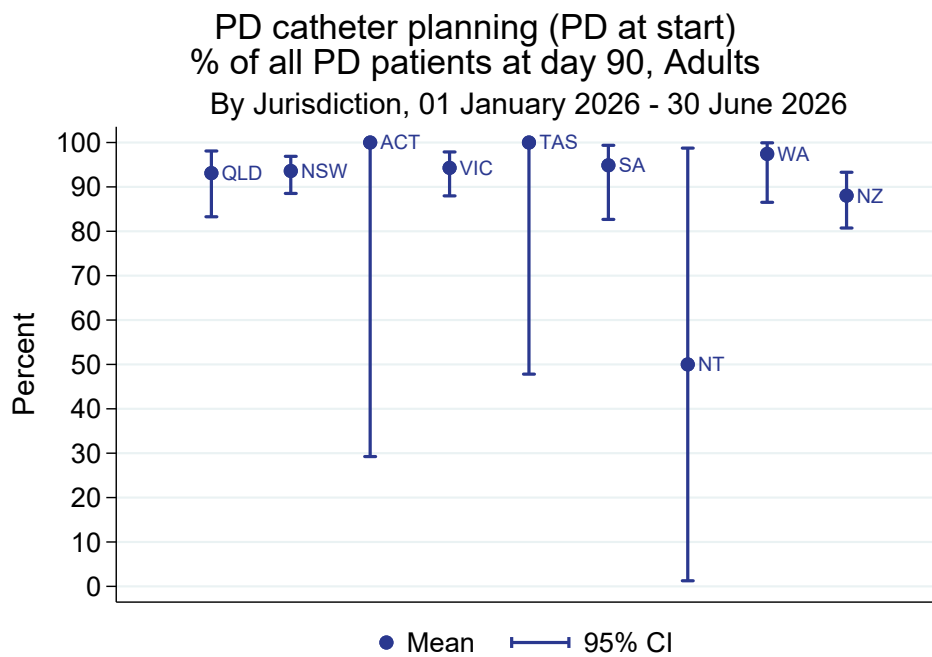

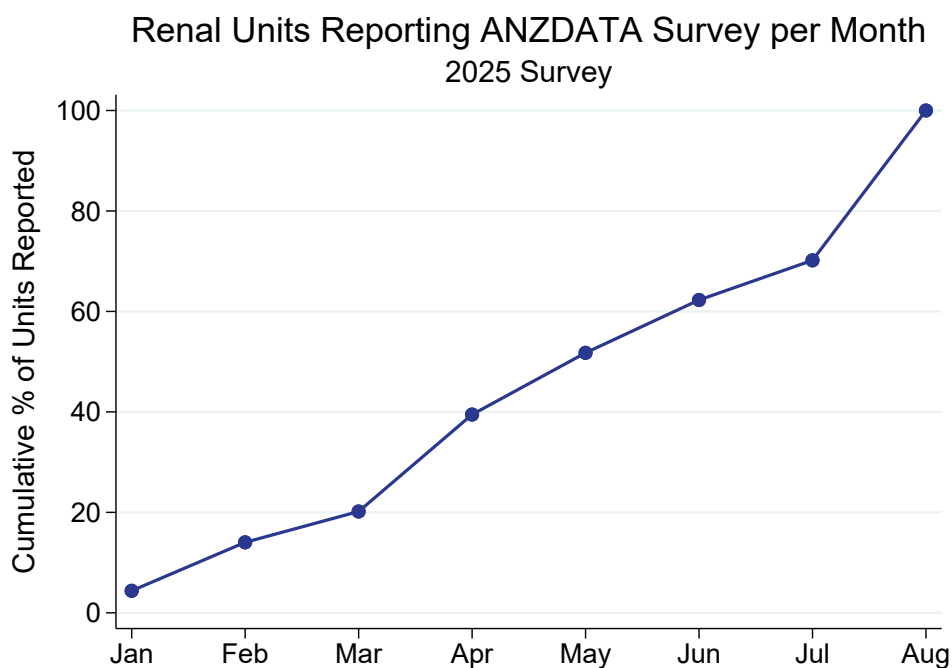

5.2.2 Paediatric

This table presents the numbers (N) of prevalent kidney replacement therapy (KRT) patients at the end of the observation window by modality and centre. Modality is categorised as functioning kidney transplant (TX), peritoneal dialysis (PD), hybrid peritoneal dialysis and haemodialysis (Hybrid), home haemodialysis including community house haemodialysis (HHD*) and facility haemodialysis (FacHD). Also presented are the percentages (%) of each modality out of the total prevalent KRT cohort. The number of prevalent patients for 31 Dec 2025 from the analysis database is also provided to allow assessment of possible under-reporting. Patients are included in this paediatric report if they were treated at a paediatric hospital. In rare cases when patients younger than 18 years are treated at an adult centre, they are included in the adult report. Any patients 18 years and older treated at a paediatric hospital are included in this report.
